**ENTRIES:** Entries must be submitted ONLINE <http://www.rfegolf.es> **by 23:59 hours, 13 February 2023.**

You have to enter [here](#) and go to the right box **INSCRIPCIONES ONLINE / ENTRIES ONLINE** and select the competition. Then, click on the box: "I am a foreign player" and fill out one player's details for the individual and both players' details required for the doubles competition. Only one playing-partner can submit the entry for the doubles.

The exact handicap registered at the RFEG database at 10am on the day after the closing of entries, will be used to establish the list of accepted players and the Waiting List. For non-RFEG licenses, the handicap certified by the corresponding National Federation will be used.

Players are responsible to check if their entry form has been processed correctly (on the list should appear "Pendiente" or "Inscrito", and once published the list of participants, if admitted. Any claims must be submitted within the next 24 hours after the list of participants has been published.

## WITHDRAWALS:

Notifications of withdrawal must be made by email to [rfegolf@rfegolf.es](mailto:rfegolf@rfegolf.es) by 12:00 noon, two days before the competition starts.

## WAITING LIST:

**From Monday 27 February, 2023**, only the players on the waiting list who have confirmed availability to play by email to [elena.vecino@rfegolf.es](mailto:elena.vecino@rfegolf.es), will be called to cover withdrawals. The players who have not done so will be withdrawn from the competition at 9:00 hours on February 21.

## REGISTRATION, ACCREDITATIONS AND ENTRY FEE PAYMENT:

Players (participants and those on the waiting list available to take last minute spots), must register at the Tournament Office before 12:00 noon, the day before the competition starts, to reliably confirm their participation.

Once registered, participants must pay the **entry fee of EUR 75,00 per player, per championship** at the club pro shop. This fee includes the temporary licence required by the RFEG Statutes and the insurance attached to the licence, subscribed by the Regional Federation where the competition takes place.

The starting times for the first round will be available from 1:00 p.m. the day before the competition starts. From this moment on, withdrawals will only be covered with players who have registered at the club.

## CONDITIONS: (pages 4 & 5)

The tournament will be played from the Red Tees or the tee -marks setup by the championship committee. The tournament will be played on the **Gregal + Mestral course**.

## ELECTRIC TROLLEYS AND BUGGIES:

The club has a limited availability of electric trolleys and buggies . Participants can book them by email ([info@lasellagolf.com](mailto:info@lasellagolf.com)) **by 14 February, 2023**.

Electric Trolley fee per day : 12:00 EUR

Buggy fee per day: 40,00 EUR

Bookings will be awarded on a first come first served basis. Buggies will be distributed so there will be no more than 2 buggies per match.

## DRESS CODE:

The player is responsible for compliance with the Dress Code of the Club where the competition is held or, in the absence of it, for wearing appropriate clothing.

## ANTI-DOPING POLICY:

All players are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy. Details of the Policy and the current List of Prohibited Substances and Methods are available from the International Golf Federation's website ([www.igfgolf.org](http://www.igfgolf.org)). Players who are taking medication and in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from the IGF knowing that, should a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) be required this must be submitted

to the IGF not later than 30 days before the start of the Championship. More information <https://www.wada-ama.org/en/international-standards>

## CONDITIONS SPANISH INTERNATIONAL DOUBLES SENIOR LADIES' AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

### Eligibility:

All Women Amateur players who have reached their 50th birthday on or before December 31 of the year of the championship, who have their National Federation or Union membership card, and with a maximum handicap of 18.4, shall be eligible to participate. Entries are limited to the 44 double teams of competitors with the lowest aggregate exact handicap at the closing date of entries. Ties for 44th place will be resolved by entry date. All winning teams from previous editions of this championship may participate, regardless of what their handicap might be. If any of these teams' aggregate handicaps were higher than the 44 accepted entries, they will increase this number. The Women's Amateur Technical Committee of the Royal Spanish Golf Federation reserves the right to increase the number of competitors by two invitations, with no handicap limitation.

Exceeding entries will be placed on a waiting list ordered by handicap. In case of ties, players registered earlier will be included.

Any double team not willing to participate for any reason must notify its withdrawal in writing to the Royal Spanish Golf Federation by 12:00 a.m. two days before the competition starts. Otherwise, none of the two competitors will be able to participate in the following edition. In addition, they will be obliged to pay the entry fee or they will no longer be able to participate in any RFEG competition until this payment is cleared.

**Participants are allowed to ride motorised carts.**

### Format:

36 holes Stroke Play Scratch over two rounds. First day: 18 holes Fourball and second day: 18 holes Foursome. Participants will play from the tee-boxes established by the championship committee.

The team with the lowest aggregate Scratch score will be the International Double's Senior Ladies Amateur Champion of the event. An additional handicap trophy will also be given.

In the event of a tie for the Championship title, the winner shall be decided on a hole-by-hole play-off. The Championship Committee will lay down, before the beginning of the last round, the order of the holes to play; otherwise, the natural order of the course will prevail.

Ties for the rest of places, will be exaequo and, for trophy purposes, will be resolved as follows: Scratch prizes - by the gross strokes of the last 18, 27, 30, 33, 34 and 35 holes. For handicap prizes, according to the Libro Verde of the R.F.E.G. , that is, in favour of the couple that has the lowest handicap sum of both players; if the tie persists, the net strokes of the last 18, 27, 30, 33, 34 and 35 holes will be compared. In both cases, if any tie persists, it will be resolved by lot.

### Entries:

Entry forms have to be submitted online through [www.rfegolf.es](http://www.rfegolf.es) by the announced closing date. The entry fee must be paid upon registration at the Golf Club.

### Starting times:

The starting times will be established by the Championship Committee.

### Prizes:

The trophies will be provided by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation to:

- The scratch team Champion
- The scratch team Runner-up
- The scratch team in 3rd place
- The handicap team Champion (\*Non-cumulative with any of the scratch trophies which have priority over this handicap trophy).

**The Championship Committee reserves the right to alter the regulations and conditions of the competition.**



## CONDITIONS SPANISH INTERNATIONAL INDIVIDUAL SENIOR LADIES' AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

### Eligibility:

All Women Amateur players who have reached their 50<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before December 31 of the year of the championship and who have their National Federation or Union membership card, shall be eligible to participate. Maximum handicap allowed 18.4. Entries are limited to the 90 competitors:

- a) 80 players with the lowest exact handicap.
- b) Next 7 players with Spanish Nationality, and with the lowest handicaps, not included in a).
- c) The Women's Amateur Technical Committee of the Royal Spanish Golf Federación reserves the right to increase the number of competitors by three invitations.

In addition to these 90 players, winners from previous editions of the tournament may be eligible to play, regardless of their handicap. Unaccepted entries will be placed on an ordered by handicap waiting list.

In case of ties, players registered earlier will have priority.

An entrant not willing to participate for any reason must notify her withdrawal in writing to the Royal Spanish Golf Federation by 12:00 a.m. two days before the competition starts. Competitors failing to do this will not be able to participate in the following year's edition. In addition, they will be obliged to pay the entry fee or they will no longer be able to participate in any RFEG competition until this payment is cleared.

Competitors must register at the Tournament Office before 12:00 noon. on the day prior to the beginning of the Championship. Place may be forfeited by a competitor from whom no word has been received by this time.

**Participants are allowed to ride motorised carts.**

### Format:

A 54-hole Stroke Play Scratch played over three rounds of 18 holes each day. **Only players returning the 60 lowest scores and ties over 36 holes shall qualify for the final round.** Participants will play from the tee-boxes established by the championship committee.

In the event of a tie for first place Scratch, the winner shall be decided after a hole-by-hole play-off. The championship committee will lay down, before the beginning of the last round, the order of the holes to play; otherwise, the natural order will prevail. All other ties will be exaequo and, for trophy purposes, ties for Scratch prizes will be resolved by card count back over the last 27, 36, 45, 48, 51, 52 and 53 holes; if still tied, by lot. For handicap prizes, ties will be resolved according to the Libro Verde of the R.F.E.G., that is, in favour of the player with the lowest playing handicap. If the tie persists, the net strokes over the last 27, 36, 45, 48, 51, 52 and 53 holes will be compared; if still tied, it will be decided by lot. If for any reason, any of the established categories failed to have any players competing after the cut, results before the cut will be considered final for that category.

### Starting Times:

Starting times will be established by the Championship Committee.

### Entries:

Entry forms have to be submitted online through [www.rfegolf.es](http://www.rfegolf.es) by the announced closing date. The entry fee must be paid upon registration at the Golf Club.

### Categories:

- 1<sup>st</sup> category: Any competitor regardless of her handicap.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> category: competitors with a handicap index of 4.5 or higher.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> category: competitors with a handicap index of 11.5 or higher.
- Age Category 60 and over: players who have reached their 60<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> of December of the championship year.
- Age Category 70 and over: players who have reached their 70<sup>th</sup> birthday on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> of December of the championship year.

***Any given category must have a minimum of six players.***

**Prizes.** Trophies will be provided by the Royal Spanish Golf Federation to:

- The overall Scratch Winner
- The overall Scratch Runner-up
- The overall Scratch in 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
- The 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> place scratch on the 2nd and 3rd category.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> place handicap in each category.
- The 1<sup>st</sup> place Scratch in the age category 60 and over
- The 1st place Scratch in the age category 70 and over.

Prizes will be non-cumulative. Priority is given to the overall prizes, to the scratch prizes over the handicap and to the category prizes over the age prizes.

**The Championship Committee reserves the right to alter the regulations and conditions of the competition if advisable reasons exist.**
